Job Description



Church Mission, Vision, Ethos and Priorities

- 1. All staff will actively **lead and serve** in such a way as to further the stated Mission of New Day Church, its Diamond Vision and its Focus, as follows:
 - Mission Statement: Loving God, loving people and making fully devoted followers of Christ.

 - ❖ Focus: Building a church for the people of South Ribble as a community of people fulfilling their destiny in life, initiating and joining ministries and groups which are strong in each dimension of the UP IN OUT triangle:— UP-worship and service, IN-belonging and growing, OUT-sharing love and life with others.
 - Supporting the agreed priorities for each season of church life.
- 2. All staff will work to **create an ethos** where our Mission, Vision and Focus are encouraged, supported and fulfilled.
- 3. All staff will **look for opportunities to involve new and younger people**, helping them discover and use their particular gifts and calling, so we see new young leaders emerge.

Job Title:

Families Pastor (full-time)

Main Purpose:

To serve God, working with and supporting the Senior Pastor in leading the Church in such a way that God is honoured, heard and experienced, that people are valued and that the Church's mission and vision for the people of South Ribble are fulfilled, all with a particular focus on the younger generations.

Accountability:

To the Senior Pastor, the Elders and the Board in accordance with the provisions set out in our Leadership Document (available on request).

Core Church Responsibilities:

To work with the Senior Pastor, the Elders and the Board in:

- 1. Determining and communicating church vision.
- 2. Prayerfully discerning God's direction and current priorities for our church life.
- 3. Overseeing the vision, strategy and plans of each Stream of church life.
- 4. Encouraging and facilitating positive "discipleship pathways" for all.
- 5. Leading the Youth and Children's Stream, and working with the Senior Pastor in supporting other Stream Leaders and Staff in their specific roles and in the implementation of the Board's decisions.

- 6. Supporting the Senior Pastor in communicating to staff and leaders, directly or by delegation, the decisions of the Board, except where it is more appropriate for the Board to communicate directly.
- 7. Being involved in the leadership of Sunday services and in teaching and preaching.
- 8. Encouraging a balanced, varied and creative church programme at New Day Church, in which family-friendly Sunday services complement and support all the ministries of New Day Church and the activities and events initiated by other leaders and streams of church life, and vice versa.
- 9. Being available to share in the leading, co-ordination and delegation of all aspects of Weddings, Funerals, Memorials, Ecumenical Services, Dedications, Baptisms and other such significant occasions in both church and civic life.
- 10. Representing New Day Church at events and meetings with other civil, religious leaders and authorities, taking opportunities to further God's Kingdom and to offer New Day Church support whenever possible.

Detailed Families Pastor Tasks

- 1. Oversee our range of church-based activities for families, young people and children and actively work to develop new initiatives with the purpose of leading families to Christ and discipling them.
- 2. Teach, resource and encourage parents in their role as the primary discipleship makers of their families.
- 3. Establish an effective network of relationships with parents/care-givers of children within New Day Church and the wider community.
- 4. Establish excellent modes of communication to keep both New Day Church and the wider community informed about activities and the progress of our Families, Youth and Children's ministries.
 - e.g. Facebook, Social Media, Church Bulletin, Friday Feed email, Dropbox Rotas and Publicity.
- 5. Ensure good systems are in place and used effectively for best practice in Safeguarding, Health and Safety, Attendance Registers etc.
- 6. Develop positive links with local schools and other organisations working with families, young people and children.
- 7. Develop and support a team of leaders and volunteers to deliver the above actions.

- ❖ A mobile phone and laptop or desktop PC will be provided for your responsibilities.
- Some office space and a desk at church will be provided.
- ❖ You will have an agreed annual expenses total for mileage, phone and resource claims which are directly incurred in the course of your duties.

Leader – Visionary & Initiator	Has a track record of the kind of leadership which births initiatives bringing them through to completion and taking team members and others with them to fruition.
Evangelist	Has the gift of sharing faith with not-yet Christians and leading them to Christ.
Team Member	Is willing and able to work as part of a team supporting other leaders when appropriate.
Self-motivated	Able to work alone as well as with others.
Good communicator	Able to express ideas, information and stories in such a way as people want to listen.
