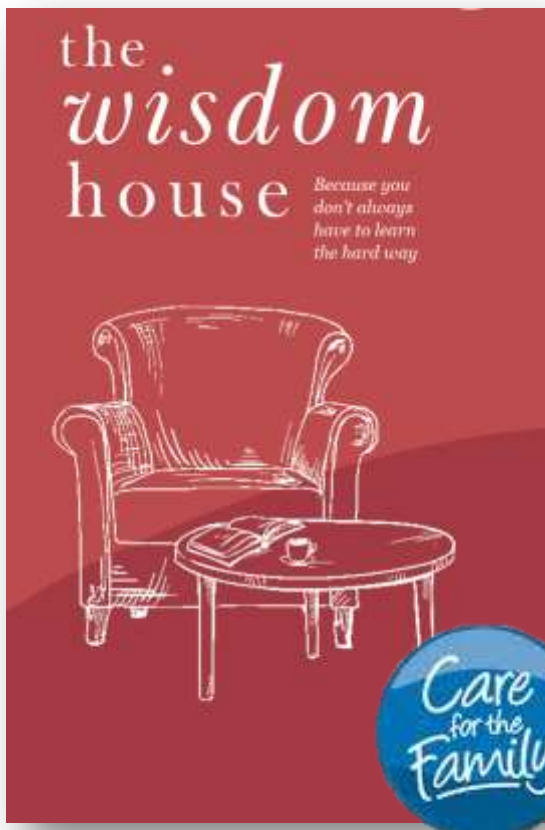

News update and prayer request from fellow Members of this church, Stephen & Mary Coates, who are in ministry with World Horizons in Wales and Italy.

“On Friday 28th February we are travelling, again, to the city of Genoa, in Italy. We will be there until 27th March. Our main focus is prayer and encouraging the believers.

Over the years we have made contacts and friendships with church leaders and other believers and we have many non-Christian friends. Every visit always involves a lot of travelling around the city on buses and trains but mainly walking. However, this time it will have to be different. Stephen underwent some minor surgery but the healing has been delayed due to an infection. The consequence is that walking will be greatly curtailed, as will the normal "hopping on and off" public transport. This may mean using taxis sometimes and will also mean that making plans to meet people may be more complicated.

However, nothing escapes God's sight, so please pray with us that we will know His plans for this "different" time and in the preparations before we go.

Please also pray for Stephen as he has now been invited to preach in two churches, one of which is an important church within the Italian Baptist network. Not only does he need to prepare the message but also translate it into Italian! Please pray that we will be carriers of "the bread of His presence".

The training is FREE, however, there will be a small charge to cover a light breakfast and refreshments prior to the training. You will receive a work book and a certificate of attendance.

The training will be conducted by Simon Bass, Director and Consultant of Church Safeguarding Consultancy. Simon provides safeguarding training for a number of Anglican dioceses and is an approved safeguarding trainer for the Baptist Union and Elim. Simon has worked for over 20 years in safeguarding within the faith sector and was the chief executive of Thirtyone:eight (ex CCPAS).
