QUESTIONS FOR SMALL GROUPS

What songs would you choose to describe your journey of faith?

How/where does God speak to you?

Are you living the “bun-dance” that Jesus came to bring?
If not, why not?

Who can you turn to if, sometimes, you need “Help”?

Do you find that, sometimes, living the Christian life seems very complicated and confusing?
How do you work it out?

Do you have a set time and place when you meet with God, or could it be “here, there and everywhere” that He is with you?

Read psalm 139.

How does it feel to know that God is with you all the time, that He made you in His own image, and that He loves you completely?

Do you know anyone who would benefit from a conversation with Jesus, like the woman at the well experienced?

Do you now feel able to share your faith with this person?

Is there any work in which the church is currently involved that you may be interested in offering help?
This could demonstrate, in a practical way, how to love our neighbour?
