1. DISCUSSION

2. DISCUSSION

It's not of great consequence whether John the apostle wrote this book or another John. The writer is describing words of <u>Jesus</u> to His church. How do we hear Jesus speak to us today and what can we do to help make sure that we hear Him right?

3. MUSIC

Soon..... "Soon and very soon" by Andre Crouch is one classic song written and based on themes from Revelation. It probably sounds a bit dated now but is still relevant. Find it on You Tube and have a listen! If you know something more contemporary, listen to that!

4. INTERCESSION

The seven churches or Revelation are long since gone. Churches are under threat today. Revisit the reasons shared on Sunday for churches dying. Then use the web to find out more information about churches destroyed in Iraq or Nigeria and take some time to pray for our suffering brothers and sisters.
